

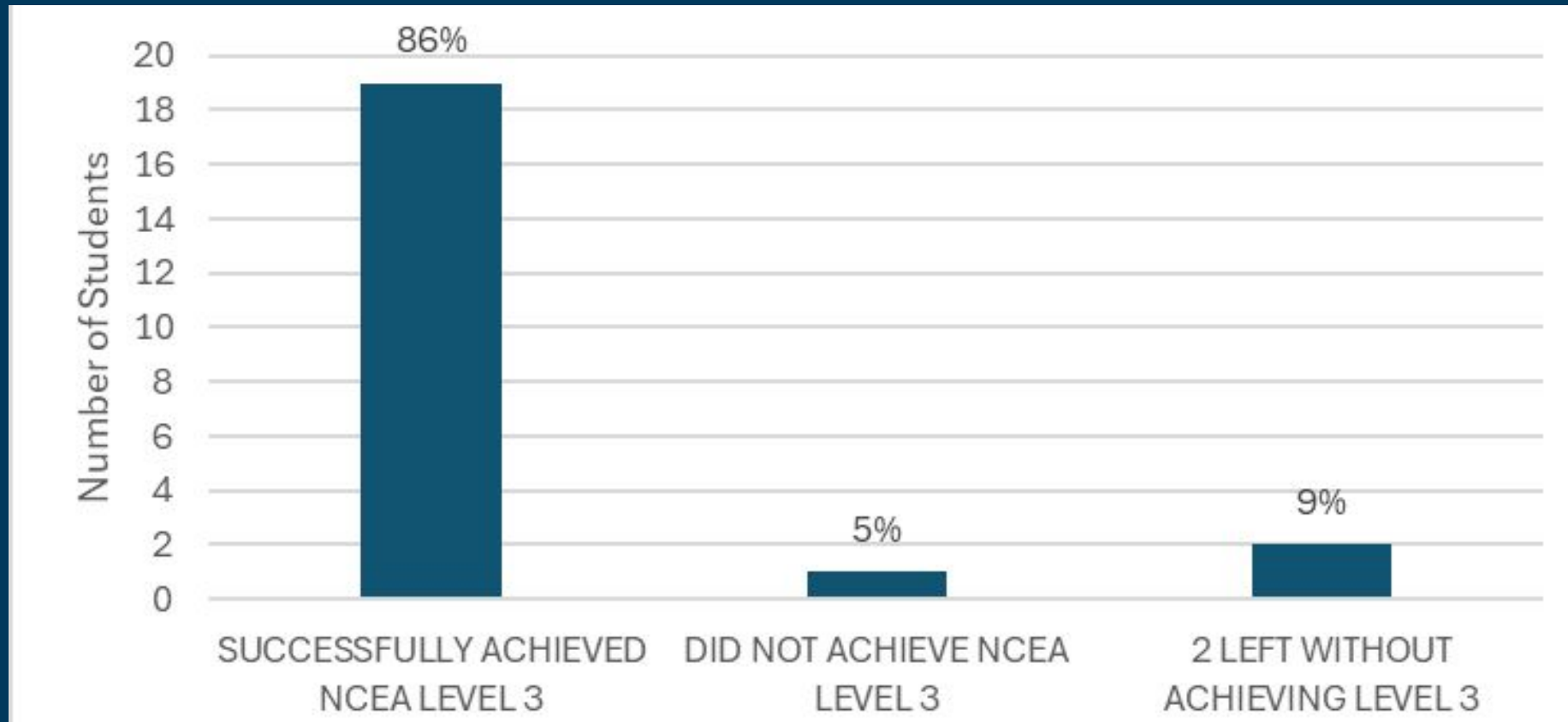
Strategic Goal 1

- Implement structured literacy across the school

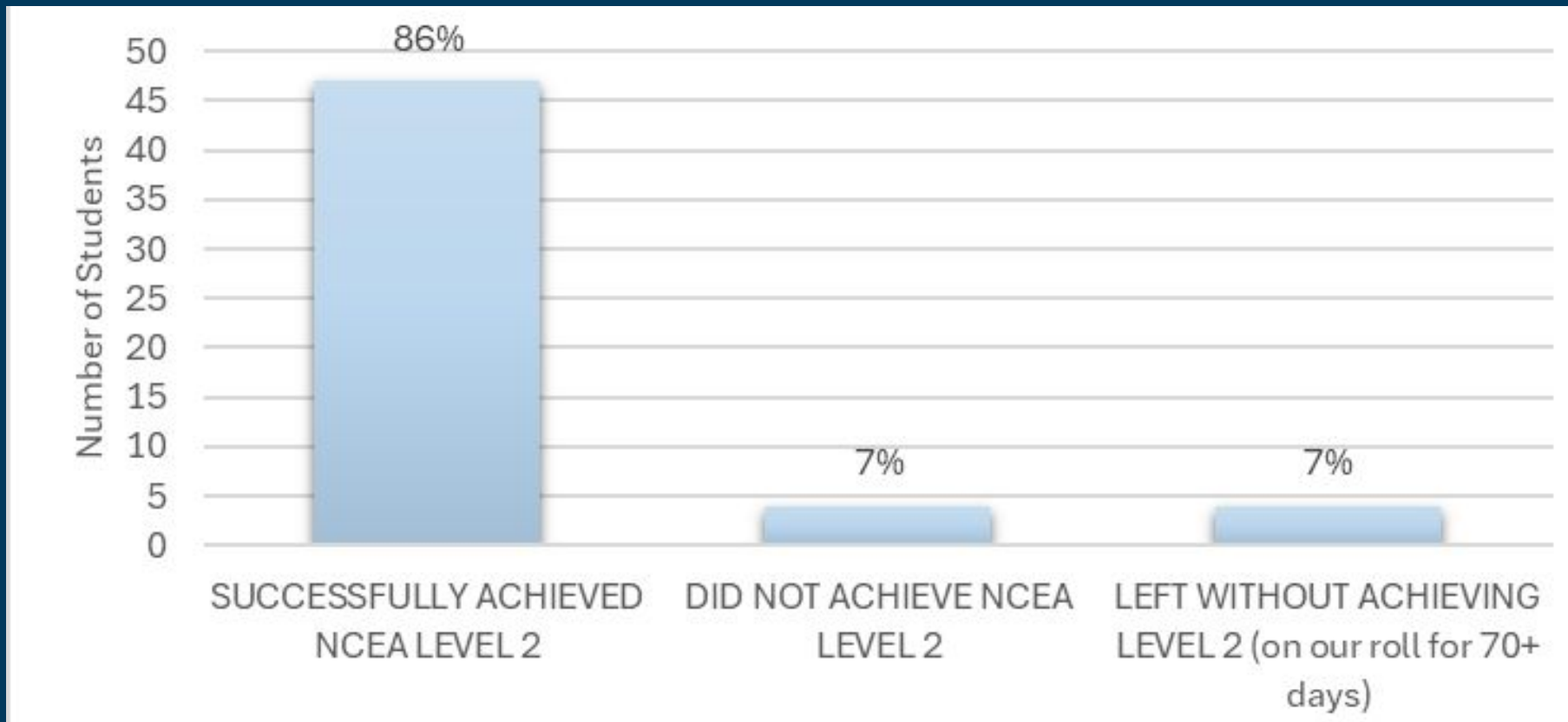
Senior NCEA - 2024 Level 3 (Year 13)



Our overall pass rate for those students who attended all year was an impressive 95%. The only student unable to pass did not sit a level 3 programme as he was new to Aotearoa NZ and our school in 2024, he was an ESOL student.

8 students achieved UE (lit / num) this is more than were aiming for it as only one student directly to University.

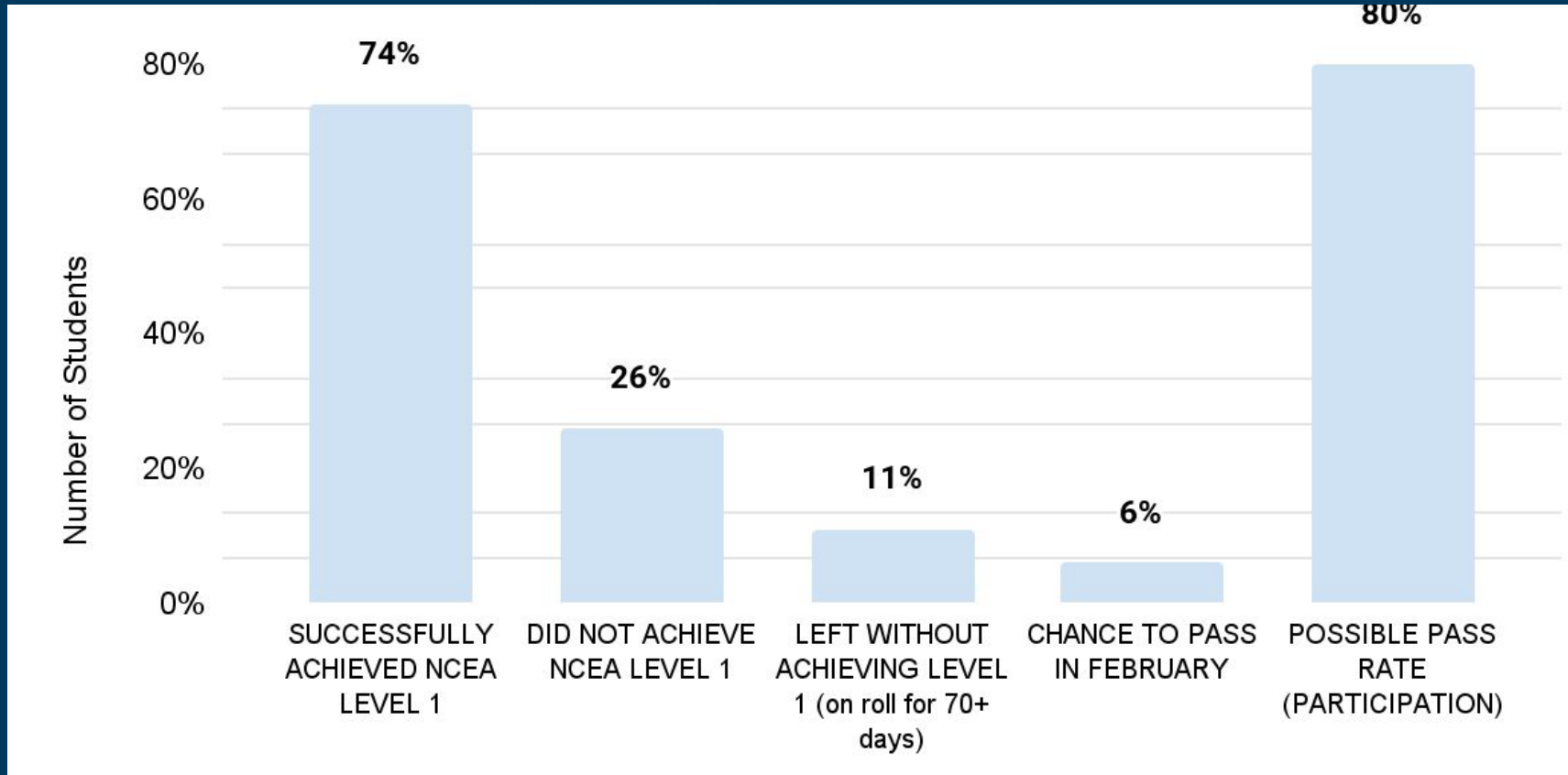
Senior NCEA - 2024 Level 2 (Year 12)



At the end of the 2024 school year, we had 51, year 12 students still enrolled.

Throughout 2024, 4 students left after being on our roll for 70 + days without gaining level 2 NCEA.

Senior NCEA - 2024 Level 1 (Year 11)



At the end of the 2024 school year, we had 62, Year 11 students still enrolled.

Throughout 2024, 8 students left after being on our roll for 70 + days without gaining level 1 NCEA.

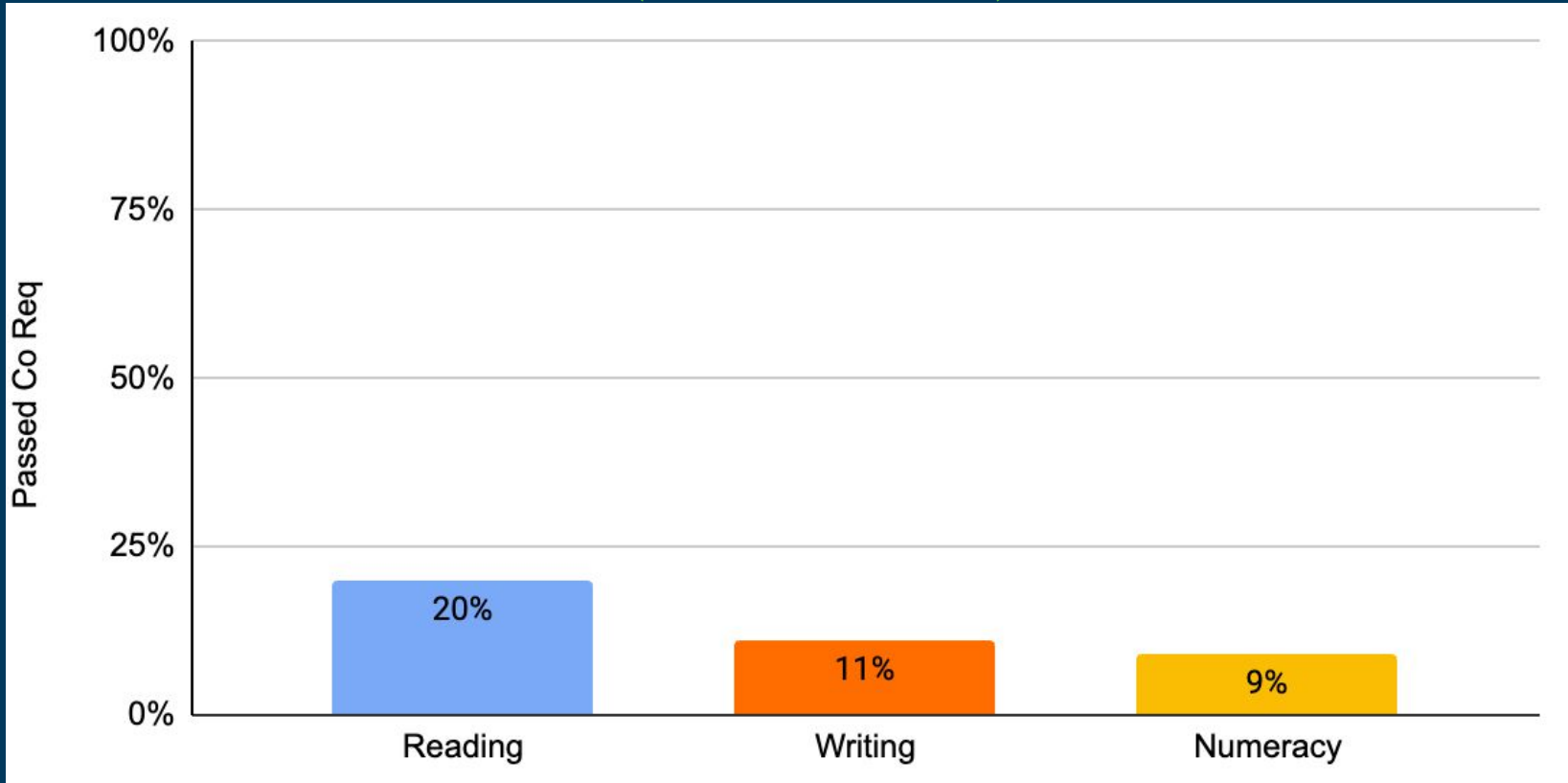

9% achieved Numeracy (6 out of 65) (28% Average for School Equity Index Group 'More Barriers')
