Whether you are attending or not, we are asking ALL parents to fill out the Whānau Survey: CTMS Strategic Plan 2026-2028. Your input is invaluable as we shape the future direction of our school.

An important reminder about our morning routines and supervision at CTMS. While our teachers arrive onsite from 8:00 am, this time is crucial for them to plan, prepare for the day, and attend important meetings. Supervision for students is not available until 8:30 am. For your child's safety, please do not drop them off at school before this time.

After school, we kindly ask that all children are picked up promptly by 3:15pm. If your family chooses to stay at school for a play, please be aware that the responsibility for your child's supervision and care shifts to you as the parent or caregiver. We understand that traffic or other unforeseen circumstances can sometimes cause delays. If you are running late, please contact the school office as soon as possible so we can ensure your child is safely supervised until you arrive.

If your child is walking home independently, we ask that they leave the school grounds by 3:30pm. Please refer to the CTMS policy on Before and After School Supervision which can be found on SchoolDocs (link on the next page). The Child Safety Policy is up for review, so feel free to add some feedback. Thank you for your understanding and support in keeping all our tamariki safe.

Invitation to Parent Feedback Conversations - Wednesday 20 August (8am or 5.30pm)

Kia ora e te whānau,

We hope this letter finds you well. The CTMS Board of Trustees is developing a new strategic plan that will take us through the next three years. Because of this, we are reviewing our existing goals and priorities (from our 2024-2025 strategic plan) to assess whether they still reflect the aspirations, vision and values of our community. We need your input!

We want to hear from you in a number of ways, both in-person face to face sessions and also through a parent survey (attached to the bottom of this letter). We hope to hear from as many voices as possible, including the ones we don't hear from very often.

We will be running two in-person, face to face sessions on Wednesday 20 August at CTMS that will run for approximately 1 hour each. We warmly invite you to attend one of the sessions, whichever suits you better:

- Morning meeting: 8:00am 9.00am CTMS Kahikatea
- Evening meeting: 5:30pm 6.30pm CTMS Multipurpose Room

These in-person, face to face sessions will be focused around three key questions:

- What are we doing well as a school?
- Where can we improve as a school?
- What do you want our school to look like in three years' time?

We would love you to come along. No registration or RSVP is required, please just come and join us. We want to hear a wide range of views. Feel free to bring your child/ren along - they can be supervised in a separate room during this time.

For your further information, the existing strategic goals that we are reviewing are:

Strategic Goal 1

Create a safe, inclusive and positive culture at CTMS where diversity is valued and all ākonga/learners and staff feel they belong.

Strategic Goal 2

Strengthen relationships with whānau and build a strong CTMS community that celebrates and acknowledges our diversity.

Strategic Goal 3

Provide a learning environment where all our ākonga can achieve to their highest possible educational potential, including gaining sound foundation skills in literacy and numeracy.

Strategic Goal 4

Help all our ākonga/learners to develop as confident, creative learners with a sense of discovery, leadership skills, and an enthusiasm for learning.

Strategic Goal 5

Strengthen how CTMS brings Te Tiriti o Waitangi to life through our local curriculum, connections with whānau and our partnership with local iwi.

Strategic Goal 6

Help ākonga/learners to develop their understanding of te reo Māori, tikanga Māori and te ao Māori, through incorporating this in daily school life.

Strategic Goal 7

Provide our ākonga/learners with rich, authentic learning opportunities beyond the classroom.
