Dear Parents/Whānau,

#### 4 more sleeps until ArtSplash 2025!

We are excited to inform you about our upcoming performance at ArtSplash 2025! This promises to be a wonderful opportunity for our students to engage with and we are looking forward to being able to perform in an amazing venue to our whānau and friends.

Here are the important details for the day:

- Date: Tuesday, 26 August 2025
  - a. There is a school rehearsal on Tuesday morning, and we need to be at the Michael Fowler Centre (MFC) by 9:15am. Please arrive at school before 8:45am on Tuesday, so that we can start walking at 8:50am.
  - b. Please pack something to eat for morning tea in a small container. Preferably something that can be put into a pocket. We will have a short break for morning tea during the rehearsal.
  - c. After the rehearsal, we will walk back to school for lunch.
  - d. As this may be a long day for your child, if you would like to pick them up a little bit earlier on the day, you may pick them up from 2:30pm. Hopefully this will allow your child to have a little rest, and eat something before the concert. Please fill out this form to let us know whether you will be picking your child up earlier or whether they will remain at school until 3:00pm - <u>ArtSplash Early Pick</u> up/Dismissal form.
  - e. For the concert, your child will need to be at the MFC by **4:30pm**. If you are dropping your child off, there will be a teacher outside to meet them. Another teacher will be located inside the MFC on the ground floor, to bring your child to the meeting point (Door 30). You will not be able to bring your child to Door 30 if you have not purchased a ticket. Please look for CTMS teachers to help you.
- Attire: Students should wear a black t-shirt and black pants/shorts to the concert. We will be wearing our kapa haka sashes and headbands, so that we can be easily identified in the crowd. It gets VERY hot in the auditorium, so black t-shirts only please (not long sleeves or hoodies).
- Tickets: If you haven't already done so, tickets may be purchased through <u>Ticketmaster</u>. There will be NO door sales available.

- Attendance: ALL CTMS students are strongly encouraged to attend this event, as it is a wholeschool performance. We have all been practising really hard and we are excited to perform to you!
- Photography Consent: During ArtSplash, images and videos may be taken of the students present at the concerts by Wellington City Council approved photo and videographers only. These images and videos will be used for promotional purposes only. At the time of registering, schools were required to agree to obtain relevant photo permissions from parents and caregivers.
