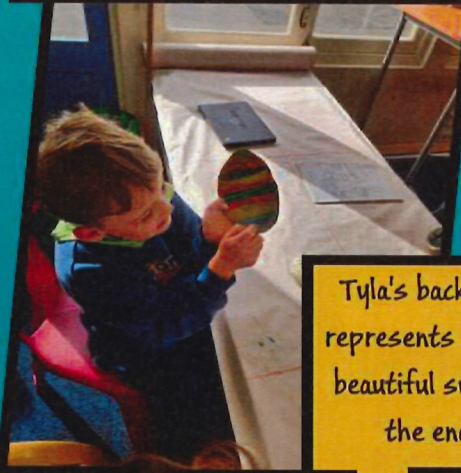
A traditional Māori game called KITE, the children made a

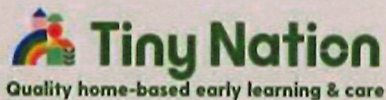
