

#### The Big Book and Boot Sale


The sale will take place on Labour Weekend, Sunday October 26th from 9am until 2pm.

Mark your calendar and plan to attend!!


Books must be in good condition, no mould or torn covers. We'll also accept DVDs and jigsaw puzzles!!
