Kia ora koutou katoa, Greetings to you all

The year has flown by so very quickly and it is nearly Christmas. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our hardworking staff, parents and Board of Trustees members who ensure our children receive the very best education possible. We are so very proud of the academic and social progress our children have made this year.

Community Consultation

A very special thank you to all who contributed to our recent community consultation. We very much appreciate the time and effort you took to submit your feedback. Stacey (our Presiding Board Member) and I have collated a summary of the results with an indication of how as a school we will utilise this feedback.

What Taieri Beach School is doing well for our students:

The majority of respondents were happy with the way Taieri Beach School is going, in particular the genuine care the staff have for the children, the personalised programmes to meet each child's needs, and the nature based learning philosophy. Also highlighted was the effective implementation of the structured literacy programme this year. The connections we have made with other schools was regarded as a positive aspect of our children's education, especially the opportunity for one of our students to participate in Tokoiti School's camp. Our great facilities were also mentioned as well as the connections made with the community through the community/school newsletter.

What Taieri Beach School could improve on:

The overall response was that the majority of respondents are happy with our current and future plans. There was a comment that the school has great positives but needs to showcase these to help increase the school roll, a somewhat challenging but very important task. The Board discussed ways we could showcase the school. We already use social media (Facebook, blog) to raise our profile in the Taieri Mouth community and the wider community. We will also be continuing Stacey's successful Taieri Beach Kids Club and the tidy-up along Moturata Road near the school. We are currently considering other initiatives to increase our public profile in the local and wider community.

Any new initiatives Taieri Beach School could introduce that would benefit our students:

The overall consensus was that Nature Based Learning programme with other schools was a worthwhile new initiative. A very pertinent comment was made that we are a small school with only a small staff and board of trustees which means only a few people to take on the extra workload. This respondent suggested that before we consider introducing new initiatives we look closely at what we will stop doing and/or who we could bring on board to help us with this. We very much appreciate this comment and always encourage community support and involvement.

One respondent made an observation of the poor quality of written language generally in New Zealand and wondered whether this has roots in the emphasis on self-expression rather than accuracy in some school's writing programmes. Although the respondent indicated that this comment was not directed at Taieri Beach School, the Board did still discuss this point. We consider our structured literacy programme very much emphasizes correct spelling and grammar.

We are now into summer and hopefully the swimming season! A very special thank you to Linda for getting the pool ready and hopefully the weather will warm up so we can enjoy our school/community swimming pool. Have a wonderful festive season everyone and all the very best for 2024.
