**Our devotional topic this term:
God Is a God of Unity**

There is so much about God that our human minds simply cannot grasp. We are finite — He is infinite. We are created — He is the Creator. No matter how much we learn, there will always be mystery, because God is far greater than our understanding. And yet, in His love, God has chosen to reveal Himself to us in ways we can know. Through Scripture, we are invited to see a beautiful picture of who He is: one God, revealed in three persons — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — perfectly united as one. Not divided, not separate in purpose, but living in complete harmony, love, and unity. This divine unity is not distant or abstract; it is the very heart of who God is.

This term, we will be exploring the wonder of the Trinity and discovering what it teaches us about God's own nature — and about His deep desire for His people to live in unity as well. We will look at how this unity shapes our relationships, our learning environments, and our everyday interactions, and why it matters so deeply in the world around us. As we learn together, our prayer is that we grow not only in understanding, but also in love — for God, and for one another — reflecting His unity in the way we live, serve, and walk together.
