### ADOPT A PARK



- Sending regular emails so that you know how much your child is attending school (sometimes people can be unaware how much these add up).
- Teach students about the importance of school attendance!

### Together we can improve our attendance numbers in 2024....

Attending regularly (90+)  • Excellent mahi!!!	34% (248 students)
Irregularly absent (80-89%)  • So close to 90!	36% (261 students)
Moderately absent (70-79%)  • We can do better	15% (110 students)
