Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L)

At the start of every term our PB4L (Positive Behaviour for Learning) focus is based on all of our C.C.K. motto. Courage – Māia, Courtesy- Atawhaitanga, Kindness- Manaakitanga

The first two weeks every term focuses on 'No Bullying'. We also strongly encourage students to be an up-stander not a bystander when they see bullying behaviour. Together we can make a difference. We are upstanders- Kia Kaha, Kia Maia, Kia Manawanui. Be Strong, Be Brave and Be Steadfast.

We are a "No Bullying School"- Bullying Strategies (Kid Power / Courage)

If you think you are being bullied:

- -Look at the person and say, "Stop it!" "I don't like it!"
- -If it continues to walk away. (This is very important if you feel yourself getting angry.)
- -If it still continues tell an adult

Kid Power actions- voice power, body power, thinking power

HERO

HERO is a comprehensive communication platform that serves as a vital link between our school and parents. It provides a convenient and efficient way to stay updated on school news, events, and your child's progress.

To download the HERO app, simply follow these steps:

- -Visit the App Store (for iOS devices) or Google Play Store (for Android devices) on your smartphone or tablet.
- -Search for "HERO by Linc-Ed" and locate the official HERO app.
- -Click on the app and select "Download" or "Install" to begin the download process.
- -Once the app is installed, open it and follow the on-screen instructions to set up your account. You may need to enter some basic information and select Riverina Primary School as your institution.
- -Once your account is set up, you'll have access to all the features of the HERO platform, including receiving important updates from the school, viewing your child's achievements and progress, and staying informed about upcoming events.

Curriculum Update from our Deputy Principal (DP) - Arinam Goundar

Learning Focus: Science-This term, Children are learning about Planet Earth and Beyond. The Junior School's inquiry is around the sun and moon, the Middle School's is around the solar system-planets and the Senior school is focussing around global warming, climate change and natural disasters.

Writing: Children will be writing information reports relating to their inquiries in Science. Encourage your child to research about topics they are passionate about and write reports.

Maths: Addition and Subtraction is an ongoing focus throughout the year. Children will also be learning about multiplication & division and fractions. Discuss with your children the strategies they are learning to add, subtract, divide or multiply. Knowing basic facts and the times tables is important for children to progress through to the next level.


A message from our Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO) - Ravina Devi
