These fun and hands-on activities help children see how numbers work and develop strong number sense!

Coaches came in to teach new techniques and run fun training sessions—and the highlight was a visit from a few Phoenix players! 





## Retelling Pūrākau Through Art

We have been learning about the legend of Rūaumoko, the unborn child of Rangi and Papa. Rūaumoko remains in the womb of Papatūānuku and is known as the guardian of volcanoes and earthquakes. To help us understand and connect with this powerful pūrākau, we've been using art to retell the story-expressing Rūaumoko's energy and emotion through creative arts. 
