WINTER UNIFORM

Next term we expect students to be in winter uniform. Please take the opportunity to sort this during the school holidays. School soft shell jackets are for sale through the school office but are not a compulsory item. Bush shirts, hoodies etc are not school uniform items and will not be permitted to be worn in class.

- All articles of clothing are to be clearly named.
- Anything worn under the uniform must not be visible (e.g., thermals must not be seen at neckline)
- Jewellery is restricted to small plain gold or silver ear studs and a plain watch.
- Fingers and toenails are to be short and free of nail polish.
- Hair ribbons and clips should match the uniform (navy or black,).
- Hair if longer than shoulder-length, must be tied back and clipped off face, of a natural colour and styled in a manner appropriate for school.
- No makeup is to be worn.
- During winter students are allowed to wear warm jackets.
- Uniform can be purchased at the Warehouse, culottes, jerseys and sports tops are available through the office.
