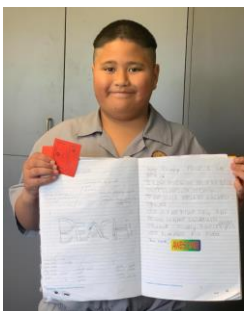

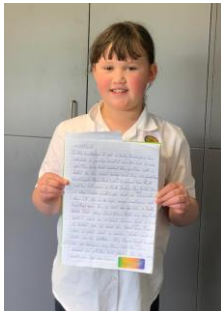
SUNHATS

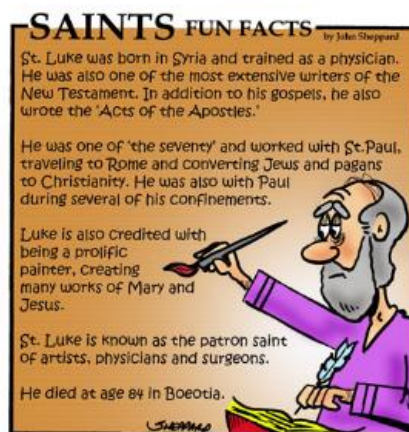


