Measles Update

We have been advised of confirmed cases of measles in the greater Wellington and Manawatu areas.

Measles is a highly contagious illness that can affect anyone who is not immune. Symptoms may include fever, cough, runny nose, sore eyes, and a blotchy rash.

If anyone develops these symptoms, it's very important that they stay at home and seek prompt medical advice by phoning their doctor or Healthline on 0800 611 116. We hold immunisation records for some of our students.

However, if there is a confirmed case of

measles at school, any students for whom we do not have an immunisation record will be treated as unimmunised and contact made with parents / caregivers.


