Next week we start our new 'SAINT Way' focus, "Think before you speak"!

At school we will be:

- Encouraging students to raise their hands before speaking, instead of calling out.
- Reminding students to wait their turn and give others a chance to share their ideas.
- Helping students keep their comments sensible and on-topic during class discussions.
- Using praise and rewards when students remember to think before they speak.
- Practicing respectful speaking and listening in group activities and classroom conversations.

You can help at home by:

- Setting an example – Show your child how to pause and think before speaking.
- Talking about taking turns – Remind them to listen carefully and let others finish before they speak.
- Giving reminders – Gently remind them to stop and think before talking.
- Praising good choices – Notice and celebrate when they remember to wait, listen, and speak kindly.
