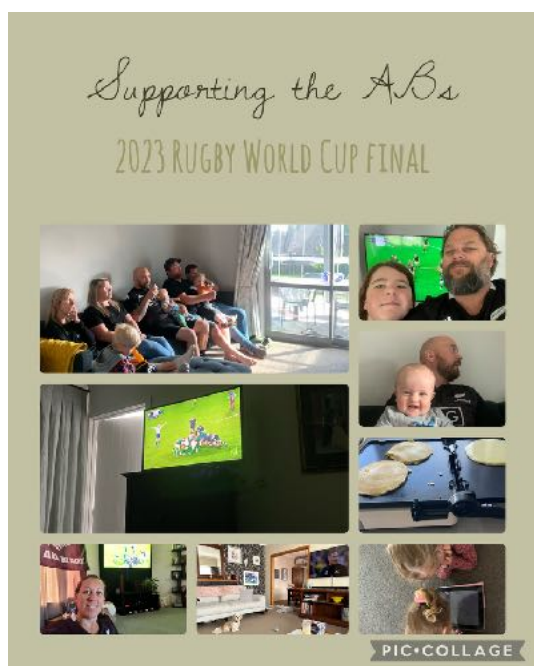

A free app for us to share notices, for parents to sign permission slips and to inform us of your child's absences.

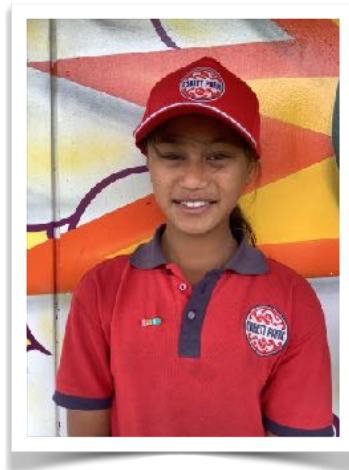


Seesaw
