Message from the Principal

CONFIRMED STRIKE ACTION

Strike action on Thursday, 23rd October has been CONFIRMED. This means teachers and support staff who are union members will be participating in the planned strike action.

As a majority of our teaching staff will be involved in the strike, it means that we cannot run normal timetable classes on Thursday, 23rd October.

We ask that you find alternative arrangements for your child/ren on this day. However, if this is difficult to arrange, supervision will be available at school. We have started to compile a list of tamariki that require this and would like to thank all whānau that have returned the return slip from the notice that was sent home early last week.

If you have not yet notified us that your child/ren require supervision, we ask that you do so IMMEDIATELY so that plans can be made to ensure we have sufficient support. This can be done by sending back to school the return slip.

HATS: Term 4 is the term for school hats. Tamariki are expected to wear a hat when they are outside. They have been given a week to get this sorted and are now expected to have these. Any child who does not have a hat will be out of the playground until they have their hat. Hats can be purchased from the school office for \$8.00.
