Reminder that if you wish to join our assemblies each week, they are each Friday afternoon at about 2:15pm and students will be released from assembly to go home for the weekend.

Attendance

There is a massive push on attendance by the government that is being put on schools to manage. The acceptable level of attendance is 90% - which equates to one day off every fortnight. To me, even one day off a fortnight is quite a lot (20 days every school year - 4 weeks).

We need our students to be at school - You are the parent, and it is your responsibility to make sure students are coming to school. 'I don't want to go to school today' is not a good reason to let them stay at home.

We have an attendance officer attached to our school now. In the first instance of repeated absences, I will contact parents to see what we can do to help get children to school. If it then continues, our attendance officer will become involved and be visiting families.

Let's make a big effort on this - there have been some real patterns emerge since COVID, like Mondays and Fridays off school for many kids.

This table from the MoE represents the impact of non-attendance during your child's time at school.

1 or 2 Days a week doesn't seem like much but....

f your child misses	Over their 13 years of schooling, that's
1 day every 2 weeks	Nearly 1.5 years
1 day per week	Over 2.5 years of school missed
2 days per week	Over 5 years of schooling missed
3 days per week	Nearly 8 years of schooling missed
