Te Horo School is involved in a Well-being programme delivered by St John for our Year 7 and 8 students. Te Horo School Year 8 girls had Pathfinders working on self efficacy. We have several students who have been supported to attend Equine therapy, some who are engaged with KYS and art therapy.

Te Horo School works hard to encourage relationships, children playing outside and engaging positively with both their peers and school adults. Devices in the early years of learning are limited and their exposure to using a device at school grows with the student.

committee for pulling off such a fantastic fundraiser for our amazing community. Bring on the next one!!




Paddy's Mart (Out School Fair - 13th Sept) Collection - NOW OPEN
