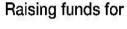

The LAWA website has an interactive map that shows you what the water quality is like at the place where you are going and lets you know the results of a most recent water sample. You can find the interactive map here: https://www.lawa.org.nz/explore-data/swimming/

These sites are monitored by Environment Southland throughout summer. The results are provided at each site in a traffic light system, with red suggesting it's unsuitable for swimming and green indicating its suitable for swimming. Environment Southland also monitors for toxic algae that could make people and pets sick. You can find out more here:

When checking the LAWA website look out for health warnings. If the place where you are going has a health warning, find a safer location. Exposure to contaminated water can lead to symptoms such as diarrhoea and/or vomiting, skin inflammation and respiratory illnesses.

Alongside checking the water quality information, we recommend you:

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\sqcup Avoid swimming for 2 - 3 days after heavy or prolonged rainfall, even at sites
that usually have good water quality. Check that the water looks clean and clear.
\square Know what toxic algae (cyanobacteria) looks like in rivers and lakes and do not
swim where it is present. https://www.lawa.org.nz/learn/factsheets/toxic-algae/
\square Follow the advice of any warning signs in place.
☐ Avoid swimming near potential sources of contamination such as large groups
of animals, stormwater or wastewater outlets and drains.
□ See your GP or Vet if you think you or your pet are sick.

Wilson Contracting will be completing pavement rehabilitation on a section of Gorge Road-Invercargill Highway between Ashers Road and Faulkner Road.

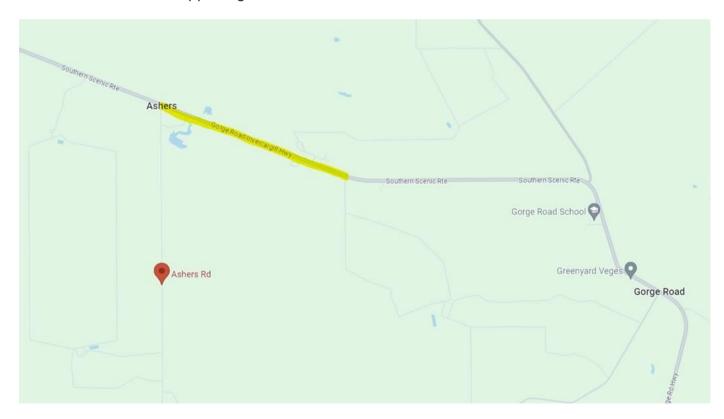
Initial drainage work will begin the week of 12 February, followed by pavement reconstruction of the road and sealing in March/April. Road users should expect delays to their journeys while this work is under way.

There will be temporary speed limits and traffic signals in place, reducing Gorge Road-Invercargill Highway to one lane in this area while this drainage work is under way (between 6.30am and 7pm weekdays).

Access to residences will remain, though there may be occasional delays if crews are working in the immediate area at the time.

During the construction and sealing phase there will also be temporary speed limits and traffic signals in place.

Site establishment is happening this week.
