We currently have 3 values and they are Ako, Whanaungatanga and Kaitiakitanga. We are adding Manaakitanga to the Taura Whiri. This is about respect and care.

It is a good time to revision as the New Zealand curriculum is currently being refreshed our our current mission statement comes straight out of that document. I worked closely with the Māori Achievement Collaborative to develop this concept as well as noticing what feedback received from our consultation questions.

Our next project is to work on a new school logo which reflects our new vision and improve our facilities and play areas of our kura.

PRODUCTION 2023

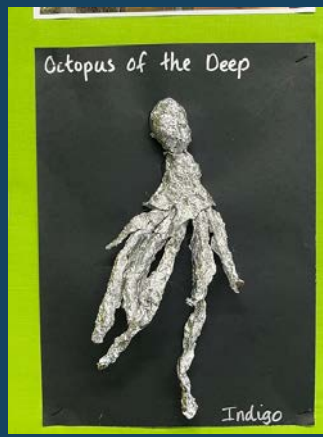
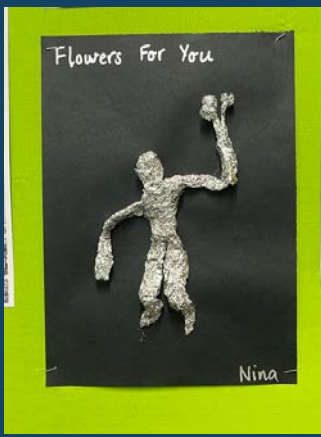

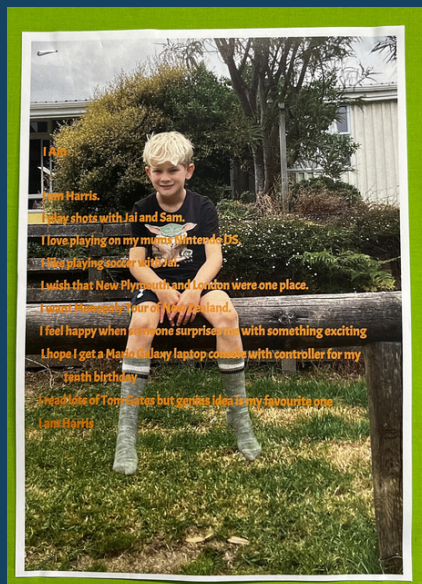
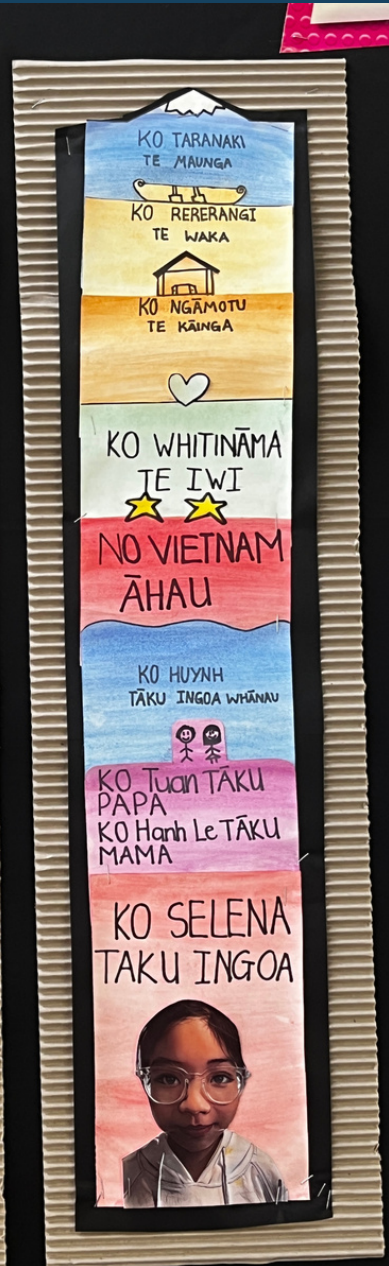
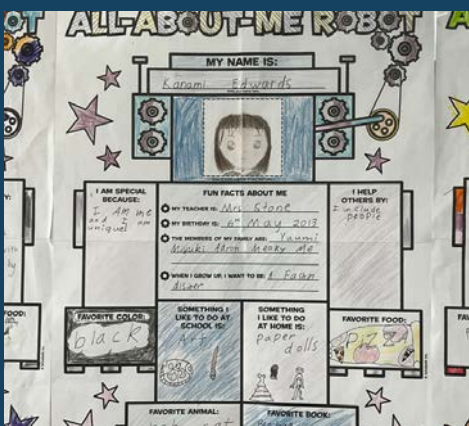
KAPA HAKA HIKOI
