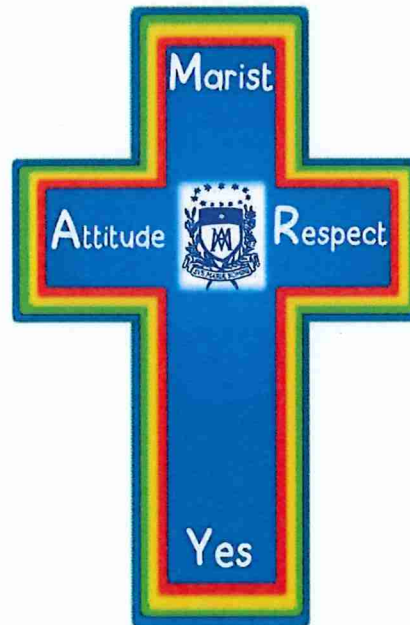

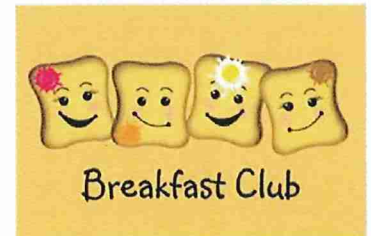
YEAR 7 & 8 CAMP

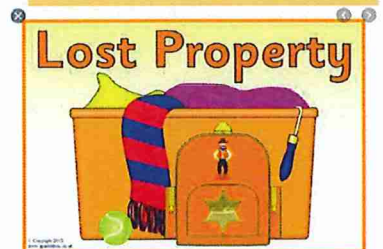


LOST PROPERTY

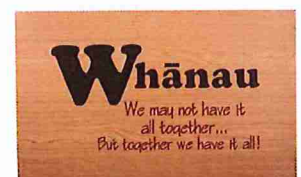
If you are picking up your child from school – please check out the lost property and take items that belong to you.

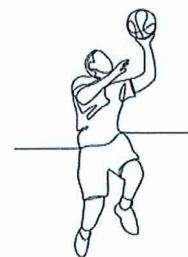
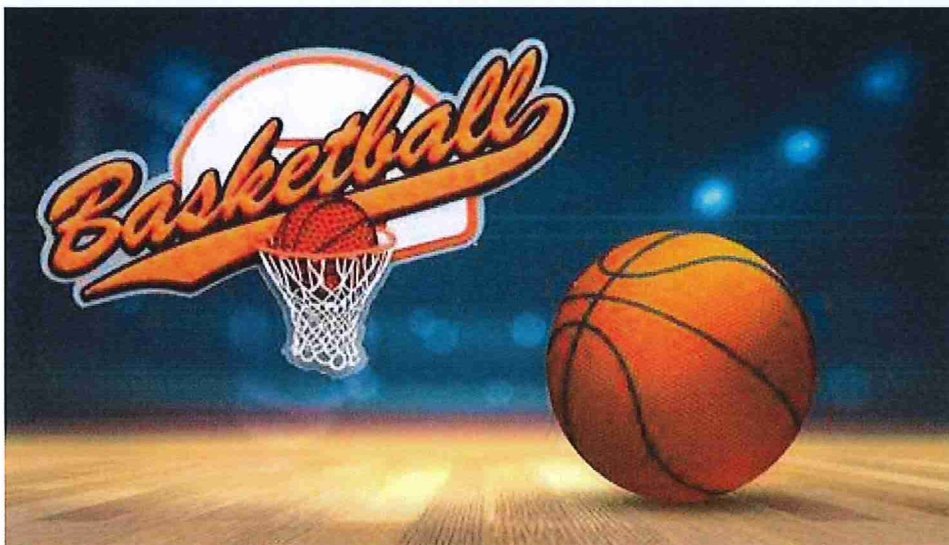
