


Kia Ora e te whānau,

#### **Water Safety**

#### **Board of Trustees**

All schools in NZ are governed by a Board of trustees. The board's role is to oversee the governance of its school and to ensure that everything that needs to be done gets done - legally, ethically, and as well as possible in the best interests of its students.

School boards meet regularly. The meetings are not public meetings, but they are "open to the public". This means that even if you're not a member you are welcome to attend as an observer although you may not have speaking rights. Craig Messenger is currently the presiding member of our school board. Our next meeting will be on Tuesday 20th February at 5.30pm. As we have had some recent resignations from our board we will be looking to co-opt some new members, we will put more information out regarding this in the next few weeks.

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#### **Bike track**

It is great to see our students using the bike track during their lunchtimes, classes are allocated different days each week when they are able to use the track. A reminder that anyone wanting to use the track outside of school hours needs to complete a contract and pay a small fee (this is used for ongoing maintenance) you will then be given a code for the gate so that you can access the track.


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#### **School Lunches**
