AGRICULTURAL DAY 2023

Matamata Primary School came alive with the excitement of its much anticipated Agricultural Day, which took place on a sunny Wednesday in the first week of term.

The Agricultural Day provides a wonderful opportunity for students to learn about animal care, responsibility and the rewards of hard work. Students bought in their lambs, kids and calves, each groomed and trained with dedication. The animals are not just a part of the show; they were also a reflection of the students' commitment and hard work.

The students and their animals were evaluated in four categories;

Most Obvious Pet: This category celebrated the strong bonds between the students and their animals. **Rearing:** Students were assessed on their knowledge of how to raise their animals, ensuring they were very healthy and well-cared for.

Leading: This category assessed the students' ability to lead their animals with confidence and control. It emphasised the importance of trust and effective communication between the children and their animals.

Dairy Type (Calves): For the calves only there is a special category called "Dairy Type"

The judges had a challenging task, as each student and their animal, exhibited exceptional dedication and effort. Nevertheless, winners were selected, and they

received a variety of Cups and Ribbons and Trophies for their hard work.

Sixteen students went on to compete at Group Day with their animals.







Middle School Girls' Self Defence Project

During Week One of this term the Middle School girls learnt about self defense and Personal Safety Education. The Kaiako taking the girls on this course was a qualified and experienced Personal Safety Educator. She helped the girls learn ways of dealing with unsafe people, situations, and threats to their safety. This included dealing with acquaintance and stranger attacks, being followed and issues relating to cyber safety. The course emphasized how students could 'think' their way out of a threatening situation, and how important it is to tell a safe adult if something happens. Feedback from the girl's self reflection was very positive.
