From The Principal

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This has been a very strange start to the term personally for myself and Miss McGuinn. We both live in Cambridge. Living in a Waikato Level 3 zone has meant that we have both been locked down for the past three weeks. It has taken a long time for travel exemptions to be granted and we

have both returned three negative tests in preparation for returning to school. We have carefully followed all of the government rules to keep our staff and students safe. Our Board of Trustees have been very supportive during this difficult time. We are both looking forward to and extremely excited about getting back into normal everyday life at school.

<u>School Roll 2022:</u> As some of you may be aware, we are carefully managing our school roll. This means there are only limited spaces in certain year groups for out-of-zone students. If you have siblings or family members due to start in 2022 who are out of zone, please let Leigh in the school office know asap and pick up a Ballot Application Form.

Covid disruptions: We have had to change or modify a few of our School and Inter-School events during this term to safely follow all Ministry and Government guidelines. We are doing our best to still run these in a modified fashion, so our kids don't miss out completely. We will be running our Beach Education days, School Parentless Athletics and modified Assemblies. Unfortunately certain activities like our Grandparents Day, Book Fair, Gala Day and Year 4 camp have had to be cancelled due to the number of parent helpers and students involved. The Middle School teachers are planning a similar exciting day for our Year 4 students on our school site as an alternative to their camp.

The Whakatau for our new families normally held at the start of Term 4 has been postponed and all new families will be welcomed formally into our school at the start of Term 1 2022.
