### **Matariki Celebration at MPS**

Matariki is the Māori name for a cluster of stars, also known as the Pleiades, the rising of which is celebrated as the start of the new year. Hiwa-i-te-rangi is the star associated with granting our wishes, and realising our aspirations for the coming year. Contrary to popular belief, there are nine stars in the constellation of Matariki, rather than seven. They all hold dominion over particular areas of our environment as seen from a Māori world view. The students have been learning about Matariki and the significance of this special event. Some of the activities they have participated in are;

- Traditional games
- Singing Waiata
- Art work including weaving and plaiting
- Dance kanikani
- Shared lunch

# **Green Team Pest Control at MPS**

A group of Green Team students, under the supervision of Enviroschool Waikato, have built a number of rat and mice traps for our school. After clear safety instructions, the best place to put these traps, and placing these locations on an app, the students, under the watchful eye of the facilitators, set the traps.

Matamata has a number of traps placed in strategic areas to control rodents and now Matamata Primary school has joined this environmental initiative. The Green team, along with Eddy, will monitor these traps several times a week. All our school pupils will be educated around being safe near these traps should they come across them.




